The Judicial Service Commission invites qualified attorneys within the Turks and Caicos Islands to apply for the position of **DEPUTY MAGISTRATE**.

Successful applicants will be placed on a roster to be published in the Turks and Caicos Islands Gazette and will be appointed as needed, to perform the duties of a Magistrate for a specified term or case.

The appointment of a Deputy Magistrate shall be made in accordance with s. 5 of the Magistrate's Court Act Cap 2.03.

The minimum qualifications/experience for the Deputy Magistrate position shall be:

- a. Bachelor of Laws Degree and Legal Education Certificate or equivalent recognized qualification.
- b. a Barrister or Solicitor of the United Kingdom, Northern Ireland, the Republic of Ireland or of some other part of the Commonwealth
- c. evidence of admission to practice as an Attorney-at-Law in the Turks and Caicos Islands Courts or of any Commonwealth country.
- d. at least 7 years' experience as an Attorney in a Commonwealth country

Remuneration

Basic Salary: \$87,398.00 per annum (Income Tax Free) plus Housing, Transport and Telephone Allowance.

Application Procedure

A completed application form and resume with current contact information accompanied by a Cover Letter and two letters of reference (one preferably from a former employer) as well as copies of educational certificates and a copy of the Passport photo page along with National Turks & Caicos Islander Status Card (where applicable).
