This is a specialized position that has department-wide responsibility. The post holder is responsible for providing services to the victims of domestic violence. He/she is responsible for interviewing and assessing individuals and families who are victims of domestic violence. They will ensure that the needs of disadvantaged persons in the communities are met.

The incumbent is also expected to support the integration of the Gender perspective into projects and activities and to ensure that gender aspects are mainstreamed and strengthened throughout the organization's two offices. The incumbent will also be responsible for designing and developing presentations for public sensitization on Gender education, including compliance with national, regional, and international observances.

KEY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. With the assistance of the Deputy Director, conduct home visits with clients, and their families (individual, group, and family).
- 2. Develop promotional packages, and activity work plans, including PSA's, outreach videos, and newsletters, for presentation to schools and community groups on Domestic Violence issues.
- 3. Manage all event operations (preparing venue, invitation, etc.) and evaluate events' success and submit reports.
- 4. Manage assigned cases plan, monitor, and review assigned cases to ensure that progress is being made while keeping accurate and timely records.
- 5. Assist the Deputy Director, with court referral, and case conferences and investigate cases of abuse and needs of disadvantaged persons in the community and implement the practical intervention.
